

## WAYS TO GIVE

A planned gift or bequest cost you nothing today but makes an impact tomorrow.

### A Planned Gift or Bequest

A planned gift to any worthy organization, not just RTK is a lasting, generous legacy--thank you. A planned gift or bequest helps you make tax-wise investments for the future and assist your family with your lasting intentions.

#### How it works:

1. If a planned gift or bequest is right for you, there are several ways to direct your bequest.
2. Choose from a specific, restricted, residuary, percentage or contingent bequest. Sample languages include:

**Specific** I give and bequeath to (insert the name of a worthy organization), a Kansas nonprofit corporation the sum of \$\_\_\_\_ to be used for the following purposes: (insert purposes) OR the purposes to be determined by the designated recipient (insert name of program or operation).

**Restricted** I give and bequeath to (insert the name of a worthy organization), a Kansas nonprofit corporation, \$\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_% of my estate to be used to fund a specific program or operation.

**Residuary** I give and bequeath to (insert the name of a worthy organization), a Kansas nonprofit corporation the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to be used for the following purposes: (insert purposes) OR the purposes to be determined by the designated recipient (insert name of program or operation).

**Percentage** I give and bequeath to (insert the name of a worthy organization), a Kansas nonprofit corporation a dollar amount equal to \_\_\_\_% of my adjusted gross estate for federal estate tax purposes to be used for purposes to be determined by the recipient organization.

**Contingent** In the event that (insert name) or any of the above named beneficiaries shall not survive me, or shall die during the administration of my estate within 90 days from the date of my death or as a result of a common disaster, then I give and bequeath that beneficiary's share of my estate to the (insert worthy recipient's name), a Kansas nonprofit corporation, to be used for the general purposes of that (insert recipient's name).
