They strictly limit the use of chemical pesticides and fertilizers in the vineyard, using their sheep herd as mowers and fertilizers instead of tractors and herbicides when they can. They rotate cattle, leaving the soils intact and the landscape rich in wildlife. They take pleasure in the work and their hands-on approach adds a richness to their products.
